About the Organisation

In keeping with public health priorities of the current times, JSS Mahavidyapeetha started an Interdisciplinary Research Unit with Ayurveda & Modern medicine to increase research and interdisciplinary activities in the health sciences carrying out several research activities.

In connection with Prime Minister's Vision of Integration of Medical systems by 2030, JSS Ayurveda Medical College conducted Integration Conclaves on Neurological disorders, Infertility and cancer involving multi-disciplinary experts under one roof. In continuation of these efforts, a National Conference is organising on Integrated Care in Neurological Disorder on 8th and 9th June 2023.

Theme of the Conference

PRAAYENA PAVANAH PRABHUH,' Vata is the supreme among the three Doshas. It is the prime force or leader attributed to numerous physiological including neurological functions. The pathological conditions caused by vata are innumerable & so are the neurological disorders. Thus, vata must be taken care of with utmost importance while treating neurological disorders. Understanding and management are challenging for the medical fraternity. As some neurological disorders are acute, they need emergency treatment in terms of brain &spine surgeries or care in the medical ICU. Whereas sub-acute and chronic Vata vyadhi/Neurological disorders with persistent deficits after surgery and ICU care can be managed through selective Ayurvedic Panchakarma therapies, oral medications, Physiotherapy, Speech & hearing, and Nursing care.

Physiotherapy in Neurology and Neurosurgery is a specialised area focused on the rehabilitation of individuals who have suffered impairment caused by neurological conditions due to the effect on the functioning of the brain, spinal cord, and nerves. Stroke, head injury, spinal cord injury, Parkinson's disease, and other movement disorders, Guillain-Barre syndrome and peripheral nerve injuries are common neurological conditions that physiotherapists rehabilitate. The physiotherapists work in close partnership with the other interdisciplinary team members. They will aim to provide interventions designed for individuals with a personalized goal-oriented target.

Speech Language Pathologists (SLPs) diagnose and offer therapy for speech and language impairment (Apraxia, Dysarthria, and Aphasia) and swallowing issues in Neurological disorders. SLPs are also involved in Alternative Augmentative communication in patients who fail to communicate through Speech after a stroke.

Nurses are involved in the physiological monitoring and maintenance of homeostasis initially and in later phases, promoting the development of coping and adaptation strategies through a mix of emotional support and the integration of rehabilitation into routine activities and care for patients with Neurological disorders.

This National Conference is intended to highlight the need for a multidisciplinary or integrated approach to manage Neurological disorders. As our Hon'ble Prime Minister Sri Narendra Modiji said, "My vision is an integrated healthcare system that builds on the best of different traditions". Also, the theme of G20 2023 hosted by India is "Vasudaiva Kutumbhakam – one earth, one family, one future," which also supports integrating different health systems to work together as one.

Thus it is planned to make it a significant event that brings together the experts from the field of Neuro medicine, Neurosurgery, Ayurveda, Physiotherapy, Speech & hearing, and Nursing to share & explore the need for integration in Neuro care.

This conference is open for practitioners, academicians, PG scholars, interns & UG students of different systems of medicine.

- The title of the abstract should be as precise as possible, appear in bold, upper case letters, and be centered.
- Co-authors and affiliations below the title in italics (the main and presenting author's name should be underlined).
- Abstracts should be sent in MS Word document with not more than 300 words with the main body of text left aligned, single spacing throughout with Times New Roman font size of 12.
- For poster presentation, along with abstract also send a soft copy of the poster in JPG format. Please include the full address and contact details of the principal author and the presenting author in the Email and indicate whether you are submitting an oral or a poster presentation.
- Each properly completed submission will be reviewed for its scientific merit and significance, and the scientific committee reserves the right to accept it.
- Best oral and poster presentations will be awarded. Abstracts selected for presentation will be published in the Conference Souvenir.


